

**RESOLUTION 23/24-31**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF  
BEAR VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT  
APPOINTING PAUL PAPARELLA AND CLAUDE TABOR TO SERVE AS STANDBY  
OFFICERS FOR DIRECTOR GEVA FREVERT**

**WHEREAS**, California Government Code section 8638 provides that “[t]o provide for the continuance of the legislative and executive departments of the political subdivision during a state of war emergency or a state of emergency or a local emergency the governing body thereof has the power to appoint” three standby officers for each member of the governing body; and

**WHEREAS**, Bear Valley Community Services District (“District”) is a political subdivision of the State of California and therefore is authorized to appoint standby officers for its governing body; and

**WHEREAS**, Director Geva Frevert desires to nominate two standby officers to serve in her place if she is “unavailable” as defined by Government Code section 8636; and

**WHEREAS**, Director Geva Frevert nominates the following individuals in ranked order to serve as her standby officers: (1) Paul Paparella; and (2) Claude Tabor; and

**WHEREAS**, Each of the above mentioned individuals is a registered voter of the District and is qualified to serve as a standby officer pursuant to Government Code section 8639.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BEAR VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT** appoints, in ranked order, Paul Paparella, and Claude Tabor to the serve as a standby officer for Director Geva Frevert.
