A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BEAR VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH IMS INFRASTRUCTURE MANAGEMENT SERVICES TO CONDUCT THE PAVEMENT CONDITION ASSESSMENT AND CREATE A FIVE-YEAR PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PLAN IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$35,775

The Board of Directors desires to hire a consultant to complete a pavement condition assessment and develop a five-year pavement management plan.

The District last conducted a pavement condition assessment 2013 and industry best practice recommends conducting an assessment every 10 years.

The District published a request for proposals and received two proposals. Staff determined that the IMS Infrastructure Management Services proposal was the most responsive and responsible.

The Board of Directors of the Bear Valley Community Services District resolves that General Manager is authorized to execute a contract with IMS Infrastructure Management Services to complete a pavement condition assessment and develop a five-year Pavement Management Plan in an amount not to exceed \$35,775.
