

RESOLUTION 26-46

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF BEAR VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT REQUESTING THE COUNTY ELECTIONS DIVISION TO CONDUCT THE ELECTION, AND REQUESTING CONSOLIDATION OF THE ELECTION

WHEREAS, On May 19, 2026 the District submitted a Notice of Election Packet to the Kern County Elections Division; and

WHEREAS, the District requests Consolidating Election Services with the November 3, 2026 General Election; and

WHEREAS, the District established by Resolution 94-837, adopted on September 10, 1994, election dates for governing board members to coincide with election dates of the statewide general election on even numbered years; and

WHEREAS, the District hereby requests that Board of Supervisors of the County of Kern to permit the Kern County Elections Division any and all services necessary for conducting an election and agrees to pay for said division to provide services in full and agrees to reimburse the County of costs allocated in accordance with the County billing policy for consolidated elections pursuant to Elections Code 10002; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Elections Code 10403, the District shall provide this adopted Resolution to the Board of Supervisors and a copy to the Election Divisions no later than August 7, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the dates of any notices, canvass of votes, certification of election and all other procedure requirements shall comply with those for the statewide general election; and

WHEREAS, newly appointed Directors will take office at noon by Oath of Office administered by the Secretary of the Board on the first Friday in December following the District General election pursuant to Elections Code 10554

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BEAR VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT Request the County Elections Division to Conduct the Election and Request Consolidation of the Election and will Reimburse the County of Costs Allocated.
