**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
BEAR VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM GENERAL MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN
APPLICATION FOR THE KERN COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK
GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF FOUR MILLION FORTY-FOUR
THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO WITH NINETY-ONE CENTS
(\$4,044,582.91)**

WHEREAS, the Bear Valley Community Services District is participating in the Kern County Community Development Block Grant Consortium; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to apply for a Community Development Block Grant for the purchase of a bulldozer for use in repairing District drainage facilities; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to apply for a Community Development Block Grant for the purchase of a regenerative air sweeper which picks up and removes debris from the roadside; and

WHEREAS, the District also desires to use Community Development Block Grant funds for street improvements and road rehabilitation of Amberwood Ct., Cody Ct., Horizon Ct., Skyline Dr.; and

WHEREAS, the District also desires to use Community Development Block Grant funds for the completion of Deertrail for fire prevention needs; and

WHEREAS, the above referenced projects are eligible for funding under the Kern County Community Development Block Grant Consortium program; and

WHEREAS, an application has been prepared for the above referenced activities.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BEAR VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT, does authorize the Interim General Manager to Submit an application in the amount of Four Million Forty-Four Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-Two Dollars and Ninety-One Cents (\$4,044,582.91) for the Kern County Community Development Block Grant Consortium for the purchase of a Dozer for Fire reduction and drainage clearance, purchase of Street Sweeper for the removal of debris from roadside, for street improvements and the completion of the Deertrail Road.


