

## **ROADS & STORMWATER RATE STUDIES**

### **REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS**

#### **Addendum #1**

**January 26, 2026**

1. The RFP mentions three studies, but there appear to be two studies, one for roads and one for storm drain. Please clarify.

*The original intent was to include gate services. When the decision was made not to include it, this language was inadvertently left in. There are only two services to be reviewed: roads and stormwater.*

2. Does the CSD have details on cost data for operations, deferred maintenance items and future capital repair/replacement?

*The District has current operating cost data and is in the process of completing a pavement condition index and assessment. This work should be completed in time to use it for this rate study. As for stormwater, there is no developed CIP.*

3. RFP page 11/Item 10 B. requests that “this entire packet should be returned with the proposal.” Can you please confirm if the CSD would like the 11-page RFP included as an Appendix along with Attachment A sample agreement?

*No, it is not necessary to return the RFP and sample agreement with the proposal. The proposal should include a statement that the firm has reviewed the RFP and sample agreement and note if there are any variances or exceptions.*

4. Should exceptions to the sample agreement (if any) be included in the proposal?

*The proposal should include any exceptions requested to the sample agreement.*
