SUBJECT: Authorization for Implements of Husbandry Use

This letter confirms that the above-listed property owner has been reviewed and qualifies for the operation of implements of husbandry within Bear Valley Springs under applicable provisions of the California Vehicle Code (CVC §36000).

AUTHORIZED USE

The property owner is authorized to operate qualifying farm equipment under the following conditions:

- Equipment must be used exclusively for agricultural purposes, including the care of livestock and maintenance of agricultural land
- Use of public roadways must be incidental and limited to movement between properties, facilities, or work areas directly related to agricultural operations, generally within a **one mile radius** of the originating property
- Equipment must display a Slow-Moving Vehicle (SMV) emblem when applicable (CVC §24615) and comply with required safety standards
- Operation must not unreasonably impede traffic (CVC §22400)

LIMITATIONS

This authorization does not permit:

- Commercial hauling or non-agricultural use
- Continuous or primary use of public roadways for transportation
- Operation beyond a reasonable local area inconsistent with incidental agricultural use
- Operation of unsafe or non-compliant equipment

Failure to adhere to these conditions may result in revocation of this authorization.

TRANSFER STATION PRIVILEGE

Property owner is authorized to transport and dispose of manure generated from on-site agricultural activities at the Bear Valley Springs Transfer Station, subject to the following:

- Material must originate from the authorized property
- Disposal is limited to **manure and agricultural byproducts only** and is **not intended for general household or commercial trash**
- Material must be free of non-organic debris or contaminants
- Disposal must comply with all applicable facility rules and operational guidelines

IDENTIFICATION STICKER

Bear Valley Community Services District will issue an official identification sticker to be affixed to qualifying equipment or vehicles.

- This sticker indicates verified authorization status
- The sticker must be visible and presented upon request
