A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BEAR VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT DESIGNATING SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING DISPOSAL BY AUCTION OR SALE

The Board of Directors of the Bear Valley Community Services District resolves as follows:

Section 1. Findings. The Board finds as follows:

A. The Bear Valley Police Department is in possession items seized, recovered or found per various Penal, Health and Safety, Welfare and Institutions and Vehicle code sections.

B. After inventorying, certain items dating from 2018 and not used as evidence in court have been designated as unclaimed, or no owner found. Certain other inventoried items have been released for disposal per court order.


C. Bear Valley Community Services District and Bear Valley Police Department also owns certain items and equipment that are not needed or are no longer necessary for District or Department use.

Section 2. Declaration of Listed Items as Surplus Property and Authorization to Dispose of such Surplus Property. The Board hereby designates the equipment and property listed in the attached Exhibit A as surplus and authorizes the General Manager to dispose of such items in the manner most financially beneficial to the District, including but not limited to auctioning on internet platforms such as eBay, direct sales to residents or the general public, or for sale as scrap material. All funds collected through the disposal of such surplus items will be deposited into the District General Fund.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution will become effective immediately upon adoption.
