

RESOLUTION No. 21/22-14

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BEAR VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT DECLARING FORMER STREETS SIGNS REMOVED AS PART OF THE DISTRICT'S STREET SIGN REPLACEMENT PROGRAM TO BE SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING THEIR DISPOSAL BY AUCTION OR SALE

The Board of Directors of the Bear Valley Community Services District resolves as follows:

Section 1. Findings. The Board finds as follows:

A. Under Government Code section 61100(l), the District is authorized to maintain streets and incidental works within the District, and under Government Code section 61060(d), the District is authorized to acquire and dispose of personal property.

B. The District is currently undertaking a multi-year project to replace its existing street signs with a new style of street sign, which, among other things, will provide for better visibility.


C. Upon removal of the existing street signs, the Board desires to declare such signs to be surplus property and authorize the City Manager to dispose of such signs in the manner most financially beneficial to the District.

Section 2. Declaration of Street Signs as Surplus Property and Authorization to Dispose of such Surplus Street Signs. The Board declares that upon the removal of any existing street sign as part of the District's street sign replacement project that such sign constitutes surplus property. The Board authorizes the General Manager to dispose of such surplus signs in the manner most financially beneficial to the District, including but not limited to auctioning such signs on internet platforms such as eBay, direct sales to residents or the general public, or for sale as scrap material. All funds collected through the disposal of such surplus signs will be applied to offset the costs of the street sign replacement project, and any additional amounts will be deposited in the General Fund for District purposes.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution will become effective immediately upon adoption.
